Version: 2010, Sept. 21st; valid from: 2010, Oct. 12th



The rules of the OLC apply, with the following deviations:

1. General

Only completed triangular flights with a minimum flying distance of 300 kilometers will be accepted. The task has to be declared in the FR before take-off. The flight and the declaration have to be documented with an IGC approved FR approved for "all IGC badge flights and distance diploma" (i.e. only flights with a green V will be scored).

2. Triangular Course

The acceptable triangular course must fulfil the FAI SC3 1.4.6 b i or SC3 1.4.6 b ii. If the acceptable triangular course does fulfil FAI Sporting Code SC3 1.4.6 b iii, a bonus of 30% (as per OLC-Classic) will be applied.

3. Winner

Pilots may submit any number of flights meeting the criteria; only the highest scoring flight in any class will be counted in determining the winner.

4. Classes

Winners are scored in the following classes: open, 18m, 15m, standard, club, double-seater and an overall class. The class is defined by the glider type used during each flight. A pilot may therefore attend in several classes.

5. National Laws and Regulations

The flight has to be performed in accordance with national laws and regulations for gliders (in particular with regard to landing before sunset).
